INI Trade Support

See below INI trade support that is available to all businesses.

- 1. <u>Business Information Centre</u> Provides free access to company databases and market intelligence reports, including sector and country information.
- 2. <u>Export Health Check</u> This will assess a business's readiness for exporting, ranging from first-time exporters to those seeking new markets.
- 3. <u>Trade Advisory Service</u> Offers 1:1 support from an export adviser to identify and address specific challenges to sell successfully outside of Northern Ireland.

Innovate UK is offering up to £25 million in loans to micro, small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs). Loans are for highly innovative late-stage research and development (R&D) projects with the best potential for the future. There should be a clear path to commercialisation and economic impact.

Smart Towns and Villages PEACEPLUS programme

The Special EU Programmes Body (SEUPB) encourages eligible organisations to apply to the Smart Towns and Villages call under the PEACEPLUS programme.

Funding is available to boost technology and social inclusion in rural areas across Northern Ireland and the border counties of Ireland.

The financial support is focused on improving access to telecommunications in rural areas of Northern Ireland and nearby counties in Ireland.

Women in Business: Explore it Programme

Support will be delivered over a 5 month period allowing time to action some of the programme learnings. Training will address a wide range of business start up issues and help to build confidence and grow business skills.
